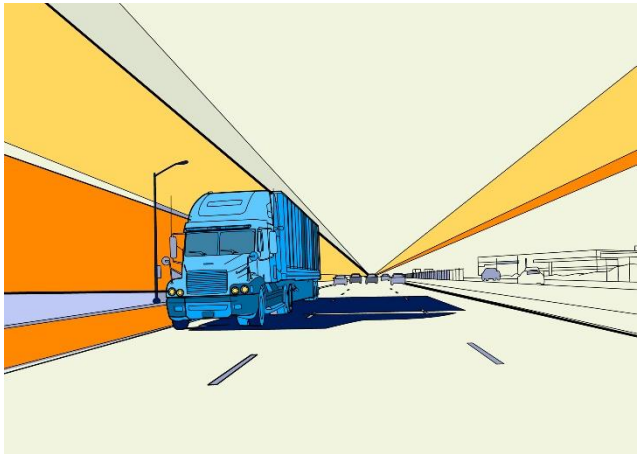


The BASICS of CSA UNSAFE DRIVING



Lane Use and Lane Change violations are considered Unsafe Driving Violations and will count against your personal CSA score and the company's CSA score. You must stay alert, aware and follow the local laws to prevent these CSA violations.

No matter what the officer says, these are NOT WARNINGS. These violations will count against your CSA score.

The only way to improve the score in this BASIC is to avoid violations and wait for time to pass. Clean inspections will not help you in this BASIC.

Preventing Lane Change and Improper Passing Violations

- Always signal your intentions 10-15 seconds before making your move.
- Always allow plenty of space when changing lanes
- Ensure your mirrors are properly adjusted
- Never pass on the right.

Preventing Lane Usage Violations

- Always obey lane restriction laws and signs. No exceptions.

Unsafe Driving Violation	Severity Points
Speeding	0-10*
Failure to use seat belt	7
Failure to obey traffic control device	5
Following too close	5
Improper lane change	5
Lane restriction violation/Improper lane usage	3
Improper passing	5
Having/using radar detector	5
Unlawful parking	1
Unauthorized passenger	1
* Severity points depend on how fast you were going and where it happened. Speeding at 15mph over the posted speed limit and speeding in a work or school zone will get you 10 points.
